
# July's guest speaker is Joy Kuebler Landscape Architect P.C.

Joy Kuebler, RLA ASLA, focuses on the human experience in the landscape, integrating architecture and the outdoors to create unique, inspiring environments. Kuebler's work includes a mix of education, commercial, transportation, and medical projects. Kuebler has designed over 18 schoolyards addressing the needs of academic curricula as well as play. She launched her firm to have a positive impact on the public's quality of life through sensitive and responsible design for outdoor spaces.

#### What is Landscape Architecture?

Think of iconic places like New York City's Central Park and the FDR Memorial in Washington, D.C. But also consider your downtown square, your local park, or even your own backyard. Green roofs, urban farms, corporate campuses – all define LA.

Landscape Architecture covers a huge spectrum and strives to achieve a balance between the built and natural environments. It requires a multidisciplinary approach involving environmental science, art, ecology, and much more, leading to extraordinary results: restoring endangered wetlands, reducing hospital stays, securing government and other buildings, removing toxins from rainwater. These are the things landscape architects are designing right now along with creating the spaces we live, work, and play.
