Koi of the Month


Koromo (KO-Ro-M0)

Koromo (KO-Ro-M0)

These are white koi with a red (hi) pattern on them that is marked with a small amount of black (kuro). They can also be a black pattern that has a small amount of red on the edges. Some people say it mat look like a group of grapes on the fish.

Aigoromo (Eye -Gor-Omo)

This is a white koi with red spots/pattern. Black outlines the edges of the red scale pattern.

Sumigoromo (Sue-Me-Gor-Omo)

This is a white Koi with a black pattern that has red on the edges of their scales

Budo Goromo (Boo-Doe-Gor-Omo)

This is a white Koi that has the grape appearance of the Sumigoromo markings on the edges
