## Hikari Utsuri

### Hikari Utsuri (HE-CAR-EE-UT-SUE-REE)

Hikari Utsuri can be considered metallic versions of Showa and Utsuri. These Koi will have a metallic Platinum as their base color. Their skin luster is what is noted in this variety. Hikari can be translated to mean metallic luster.

**Kin Showa (Kin-rin-sho-wa)**  
This koi is black with red and white patterns. Their scales have a metallic look to them. Sometimes referred to a metallic Showa.



**Kin Hi Utsuri (Kin-he-ut-sue-ree)**  
This koi is black with a red pattern. Their scales have a metallic look to them. Sometimes referred to a metallic Hi (for red) Utsuri



**Kin Ki Utsuri (Kin-key-ut-sue-ree)**  
This koi is black with a yellow pattern. Their scales have a metallic look to them. Sometimes referred to as a metallic Ki Utsuri.



**Ginshiro (Gin-she-ro)**  
This is a black koi with a white pattern. Their scales have a metallic look to them. Sometimes referred to as a Shiro Utsuri



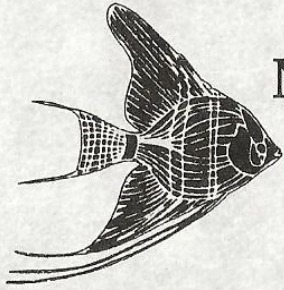
