

## Kohaku (Co-Haku)


This koi is white (shiro) with a red (hi) pattern on them. Depending on the location and number of red spots, their name can be determined. It is said a good pond will have 1/3 of its fish population to be some form of a Kohaku. Nine styles that can be seen at Koi Shows would be:

Kuchibeni (Coo-Chee-Benny) - This is a white Koi with a red pattern that is located on the month region. Some call this the "lipstick" fish.

Maruten (Mar-Oo-Ten) -This is a white Koi with a red pattern located on the center of the head. It looks likes the fish could be wearing a red "crown". Nidan (Knee-Dan) - This is a white koi with two well defined red spots. You will also see some small black shapes as well. Menkaburi (Men-Cab-Oo-Ree) - This is a white koi with the red pattern coving the crown of the head to its mouth.











Tancho (Tan-Cho) - This is a white koi that has one red spot on the middle of its head. It is similar in appearance to a bull's eye. Inazuma (In-A-Zoom-A) -This is a white koi with a red pattern that resembles a lightening bolt. Yondan (Yon-Dan) - This is a white koi with a red pattern that looks like steps. This pattern has 4 red steps

Sandan (San-Dan) - This is a white koi with a red pattern like steps. However this koi only has three such steps.











Straight Hi (Straight-He) -This is a white koi with a red pattern of one step. One long red pattern from mid head to base of tail, can be seen on this koi.
