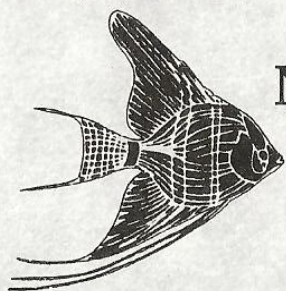

## Carnivorous Plants for sale from Greg Young

All are priced at either \$25 or \$50, which is a real bargain given the number of plants you are getting.

The pitcher plants are starting to go dormant, but the older pitchers are still there so you will get an idea of what they look like.

The same thing with the Venus fly and Sundew.

The only ones that don't go dormant/slow down their growth are the Nepenthes. I will cut the Nepenthes back so they can be transported easily.

Details are:

All the plants (except Nepenthes) contain multiple plants in each pot which can be immediately divided to greatly expand your collection, or you could keep them as is, for a showy pot/basket.

The Venus fly, Sundews and Pitcher plants are in pots. The Nepenthes are in wooden weave hanging baskets.

Pricing is:

Venus fly: *Dionaea muscipula* in 6 inch pot \$25 ; *Dionaea muscipula*, and Aka-Ryu (red variety) in 13 inch show bowl \$50

Sundews: *Drosera binata* with living sphagnum moss in 13 inch show bowl \$50;

Nepenthes: *N. sanguinea* pink in basket \$50; *N. ventricosa* in basket \$50

Pitchers: *Sarracenia alata* in 10 inch pot \$50; *Sarracenia leucophylla* in 12 inch pot \$50; *Sarracenia minor* in 10 inch pot \$50; *Sarracenia oreophila* (the actual species, not a hybrid, and can no longer be obtained as it is on the endangered species list) in 10 inch pot \$50; *Sarracenia rubra* ssp Wherry in 6 inch pot \$25
