Clean-up at the Botan's will take place on June 14th at 9AM. We generally need to remove all the fish, so any totes you can bring would be appreciated.

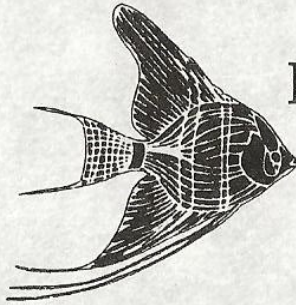
I'm still looking for participants for this years Pond Tour taking place on July 26th. Beat the rush and let me know at the June meeting if your willing to dazzle us with your pond.
