We are going to assemble a sculpture to be displayed at the club's Erie County Fair pond this year.

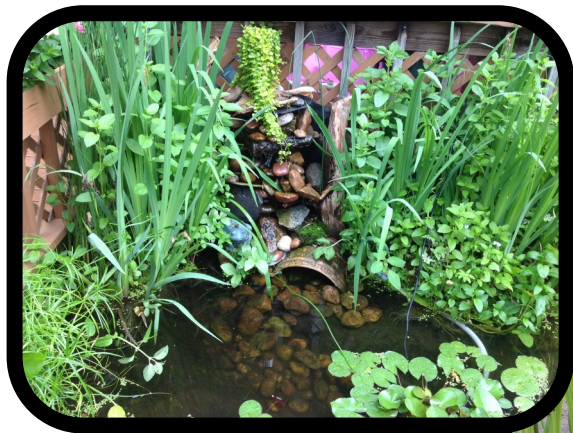
