also organize a basket raffle. This has brought in an additional \$200 - \$300 in the past years.

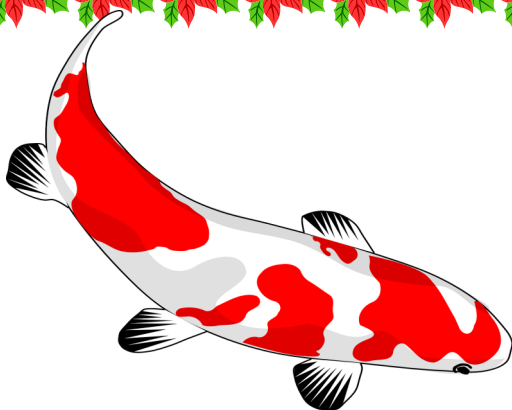

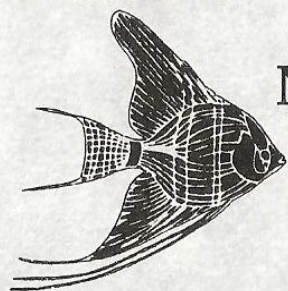
